# What Do You Need To Know About Our Program?

What can you gain from a driver education class?

- Driver education will provide you with the opportunity to learn information and skills you will need to become a safe driver
- Knowledge of Tennessee Department of Safety Rules and Regulations
- Learn to recognize all Tennessee road signs, signals and pavement markings
- Individual road driving instruction
- Class instruction to prepare for obtaining permit or Tennessee Driver License
- Lower Insurance Rates (check with your personal insurance agent for company policy)

Who do we serve?

- Anyone and everyone that has reached the age of 15 and is qualified to drive
- Adults that want to learn to drive
- Anyone in the need of a refresher driving course
- Students with Disabilities
- Department of Children's Service clients
- Vocational Rehab students
- Disabled Veterans that may require retraining in order to become independent

What are the hours of operation and the cost for driver education training?

- The five week classes are held on either Monday-Wednesday or Tuesday-Thursday from 5:00 until 8:00pm. Driving hours are scheduled for your convenience. The cost for the thirty-six hour class is \$300.00.

Bad Weather Policy

Our primary concern is the safety of our students. In order for students to become good drivers he/she will receive driving instruction in all favorable weather conditions. (However, student drives will be cancelled during tornado warnings or severe snow storms.)

Is any type of financial aid offered to help with the cost of the Driver Education course?
