**UCHRA's SENIOR COMMUNITY SERVICE EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM**

It's never too late in life to embark on a new career. This happens sometimes by choice and other times by necessity. For those who are 55+ years of age and interested in job training and employment, the Upper Cumberland Human Resource Agency's (UCHRA) Senior Community Service Employment Program (SCSEP), also known as Title V, can provide meaningful part-time paid work experience in community services. The main purpose of the program is to provide opportunities for older workers to obtain meaningful unsubsidized jobs in private industry or the public sector.

A person must not only be 55 years of age or older, but meet other eligibility guidelines to qualify for SCSEP. Training sites for work experience are developed in non-profit organizations or government offices. Training sites may include, but are not limited to the following: schools, hospitals, senior citizen centers, literacy instruction, nutrition programs, and daycare centers.

"Individuals participating in this program are eligible to receive certain benefits. Cost assistance for annual physical examinations, job-related counseling, job training, earned wages, unsubsidized jobs, and meaningful employment are just a few. The Senior Community Service Employment Program can be of great value to eligible individuals." Stated Phyllis Bennett, UCHRA's Executive Director.
